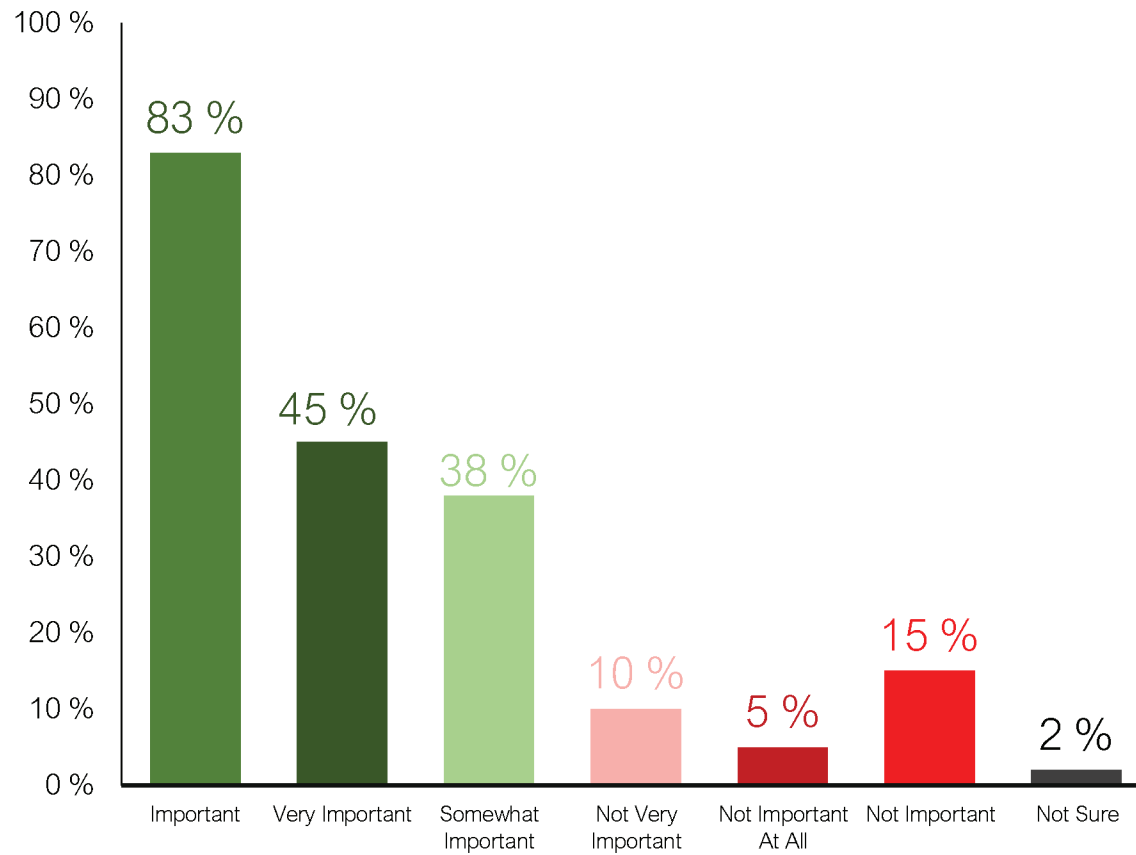

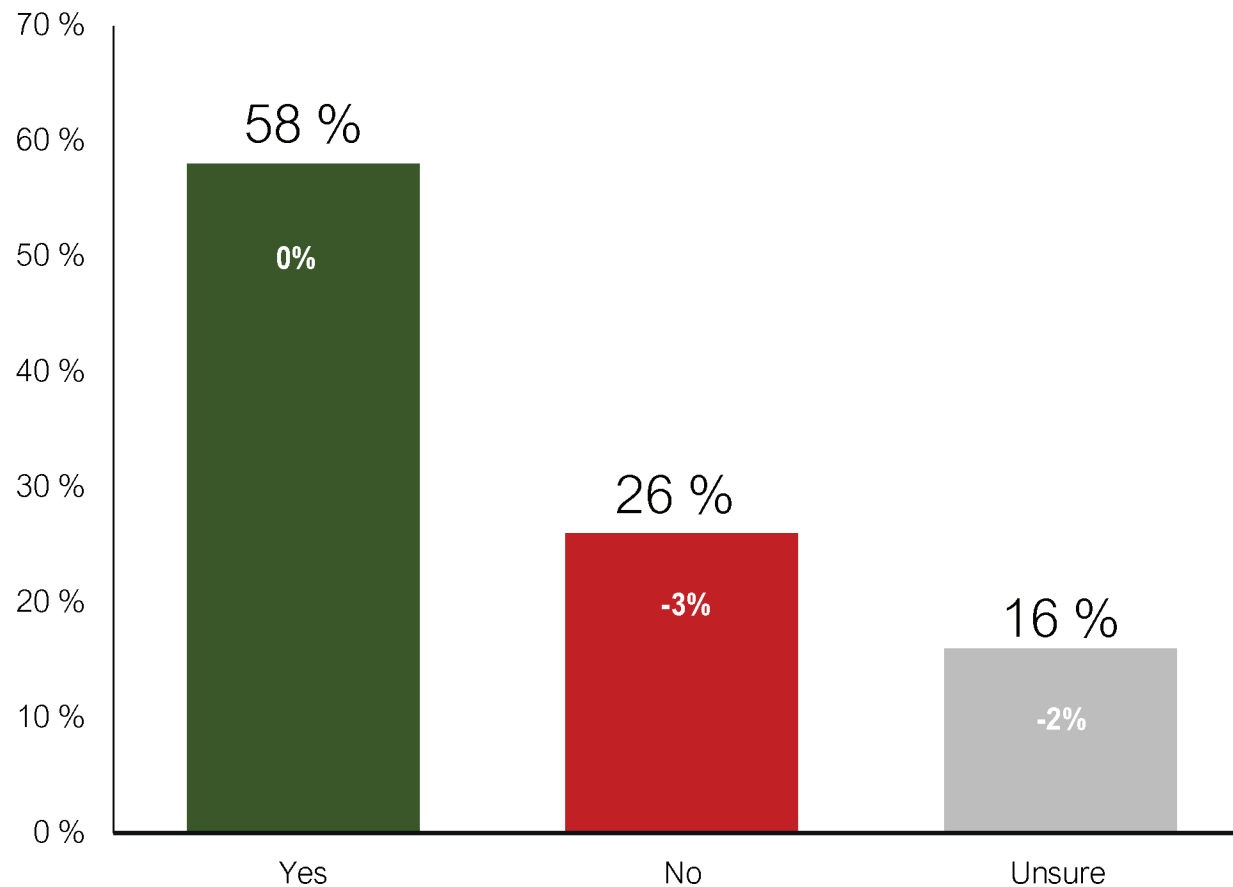
Importance of Energy Issues —
