


How important will energy issues be to your vote in the election? Would you say it's **very important**, somewhat important, not that important or **not important at all**?


Technological Ability to Explore —

Support/Oppose: Offshore Energy Exploration


Generally speaking, do you support or oppose offshore energy exploration and production in the Gulf of Mexico?
