Oil and gas revenue accounts for roughly one-third of New Mexico's General Fund — helping pay for Medicaid, hospitals, public health programs, and new community health facilities. These dollars have supported expanded healthcare coverage, statewide early childhood programs, and nearly \$1 billion dedicated to training the next generation of nurses and medical professionals.

Growing energy activity also strengthens local tax bases, enabling projects like the \$75 million hospital planned in Hobbs to serve a rapidly expanding community. And beyond funding, oil and natural gas supply the plastics, microchips, and advanced materials used in life-saving medical devices and emergency care.
